Last week, the group triggered its business continuity plan in order to maintain its essential activities in compliance with government and inter-professional directives, by stopping all non-essential travel and by generalizing teleworking. In order to ensure the future, Vranken-Pommery Monopole has also taken a series of measures to cope with the significant drop in business:

- stop in the hospitality expenses
- Introduction of short-time working for the entire group and childcare facilities

- Request for deferral of social security contributions and tax deadlines
